

PMI Global Congresses present a unique opportunity for certified Project Management Professionals (PMP®) to earn a significant amount of professional development units (PDU) toward maintenance of their credential. One PDU is earned for every one hour spent in a planned, structured learning experience or activity. Fractions of PDUs may be reported in 0.25 increments following one full hour.

This PDU Calculation Worksheet lists all activities that qualify for PDUs at PMI Global Congress 2005–EMEA (23-25 May) as well as those at the PMI Leadership Meeting (22 May), the PMI Research Programme Working Session (21 May), and the PMI Standards Programme Working Session (23 May). PDUs earned at these events are classified under Category 3, and should be claimed using **Programme Number 2000HQ40232**. PDUs earned at SeminarsWorld® activities taking place immediately after the congress (26-27 May), must be reported separately, as each seminar has its own programme number.

Mark the activities you attended on this PDU Calculation Worksheet, and then claim the total PDUs you earned on a Continuing Certification Requirements (CCR) Activity Reporting Form. Do NOT include this worksheet when submitting the completed Activity Reporting Form. Instead, keep it with your personal records for verification of attendance if you are audited.
