

PMI Global Congresses present a unique opportunity for certified Project Management Professionals (PMP®) to earn a significant amount of professional development units (PDU) toward maintenance of their credential. One PDU is earned for every one hour spent in a planned, structured learning experience or activity. Fractions of PDUs may be reported in 0.25 increments following one full hour.

This PDU Calculation Worksheet lists all activities that qualify for PDUs at PMI Global Congress 2005–Asia Pacific (21-23 February) as well as those at the PMI Leadership Meeting immediately preceding the congress (20 February). PDUs earned at these events are classified under Category 3, and should be claimed using Programme Number **2000-HQ40231**. PDUs earned at SeminarsWorld® activities taking place immediately after the congress, 24-25 February, must be reported separately, as each seminar has its own programme number.

Mark the activities you attended on this PDU Calculation Worksheet, and then claim the total PDUs you earned on a Continuing Certification Requirements (CCR) Activity Reporting Form.
