



Free Workshop Introduces Project Management to Not-for-Profit Organizations

The Nonprofit Resource Network, an organization associated with **Millersville University** in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, USA, has created a workshop to introduce the basics and benefits of project management to not-for-profit organizations.

The workshop provides an introduction to not-for-profits and aims to show how these organizations can implement and manage projects on a daily basis—from planning fundraising events to developing a staff orientation to putting together a new program for clients.
