I/We have received your notice offering publication/presentation of my/our paper and accept this invitation by agreeing to the following conditions:

1. The paper (hereinafter "Contributed Work") will be completed in the required format, be relevant to the submitted abstract, meet all submission deadlines as provided, and be ready for presentation at the PMI Global Congress as scheduled by PMI. PMI reserves the right to cancel, at any time, Contributed Works and their presentation if all conditions herein stated and subsequently provided to the author through normal means of correspondence are not met. Any and all decisions by PMI and/or the Congress Project Action Team (CoPAT) are final.
2. Author(s) represent and warrant that either (1) he/she/they (a) are the sole author(s) of the Contributed Work, (b) now own all rights in it granted hereunder, free of liens or encumbrances and (c) have full power to execute this Agreement or (2) that the work is in the public domain.
3. Author(s) will obtain any permission or clearance required for the subject matter of the Contributed Work by their employer or any other organization or individual prior to submitting the Contributed Work, and represent and warrant that the Contributed Work is original, has not been published or presented publicly prior to the date of the Congress, and does not infringe the statutory copyright or common law literary rights of others, or violate the rights of privacy or libel other persons. If the Contributed Work contains copyrighted material owned by a third party, the Author(s) agrees to obtain written permission from the copyright owner to use the copyrighted material in the Contributed Work and shall promptly deliver such written permission to PMI.
4. PMI reserves the right to reject papers or presentations concerning PMI products or services that are under development unless the presenter is a current active member of project's "leadership" team (e.g. guidance, core, etc) and the content of their paper or presentation has been approved by the relevant PMI HQ Program Director. This policy applies to products or services under development in the areas including but not limited to standards, certification and research. This policy does not apply to products or services that are currently available in the market place.
5. Author(s) agree(s) to indemnify and hold harmless PMI, its licensees, assignees and contractors in any action arising out of facts which constitute a breach of the aforementioned representations and warranties and hold them harmless for any and all third party claims, damages, liabilities, costs, charges and expenses including reasonable attorney's fees arising out of any breach of the aforementioned representations and warranties or relating to the content of the published paper or its presentation.
6. 
