



## **Jerry King Memorial Scholarship for Project Management Excellence *Information, Application Process, and Application***

### ***Information***

The friends of Jerry King are sponsoring the Jerry King Memorial Scholarship for Project Management Excellence through the PMI Educational Foundation with an award of up to US\$1,000. This project management professional development scholarship is for project management practitioners, school teachers, and/or non-profit/NGO employees.

The eligibility criteria are as follows:

- First preference is given to PMI Chapter members, active volunteers, or family members of a member or volunteer within the PMI Region 7 geography (California, Hawaii, New Mexico, Nevada, and Arizona).
- Others who may apply include certificated teachers, school administrators, non-profit staff, or project managers (unemployed or employed less than 40 hours per week and seeking full-time employment) who are residents within the PMI Region 7 geography (California, Hawaii, New Mexico, Nevada, and Arizona).

The award recipient must be planning to enroll or currently enrolled in a PMI Registered Education Provider (REP) offered certificate or Project Management training program such as a CAPM<sup>®</sup>, PMP<sup>®</sup>, PgMP<sup>®</sup>, or other PMI-certification or re-certification training program. This scholarship will only cover the cost of the course up to US\$1,000. It will not cover other expenses such as travel, lodging, books for the course, or any other expenses.

If you are selected to receive a scholarship, you must register within 30 days of being awarded the scholarship if you aren't registered already. Once you send proof of registration and proof of payment for the course, you will get reimbursed. Proof of payment can be a confirmation e-mail from the PMI REP or any other document that they give you confirming payment.
