



Project of the Year Award

The PMI Karachi Chapter invites nominations for the **Project of the Year Award**, recognizing an outstanding project that demonstrates excellence in project management while delivering measurable business, organizational, or societal value.

Projects from **all industries and sectors** are encouraged to apply, including private sector, government, nonprofit organizations, healthcare, education, infrastructure, technology, manufacturing, construction, financial services and transformation initiatives.

Eligibility

A project is eligible if it:

- Was substantially completed during the award eligibility period (between 1st Jul 2024 to 1st Jul 2026)
- Was delivered by an organization or project team with a professional connection to the Chapter's geographic area i.e. within and for Sindh region only
- Demonstrates measurable business, organizational, customer, or strategic benefits.
- Applies recognized project management practices.
- Includes sufficient evidence to support evaluation.

Who May Nominate

Nominations may be submitted by:

- Project Manager
- Project Sponsor
- PMO Leader
- Employer or Client
- Authorized Organizational Representative

Self-nominations are permitted.



Ineligibility

Projects are not eligible if they:

- Are still in early execution without measurable outcomes.
- Cannot be evaluated due to confidentiality restrictions.
- Contain incomplete or unverifiable information.
- Present unresolved ethical or conflict-of-interest issues.

What Judges Will Evaluate

Submissions will be assessed against criteria aligned with PMI Global Awards, including:

Criterion	Weight
Context and Challenge Identification	15%
Stakeholder Engagement and Value Perception	15%
Outcomes, Value, and Category Alignment	25%
Demonstration of Project Management Excellence	20%
Demonstration of PMI Culture Values	10%
Overall Project Success	15%

Submission Package

Applicants should submit:

- Completed online nomination form
- Project summary
- Responses addressing each evaluation criterion
- Supporting evidence (where available), including project metrics, dashboards, reports, testimonials, photographs, publications, or other relevant documentation



- Optional presentation or case study

- **Finalist Presentations (if applicable):** Last week of October
- **Awards Ceremony:** International Project Management Day
