DATE: 25 – 28 October, 2022

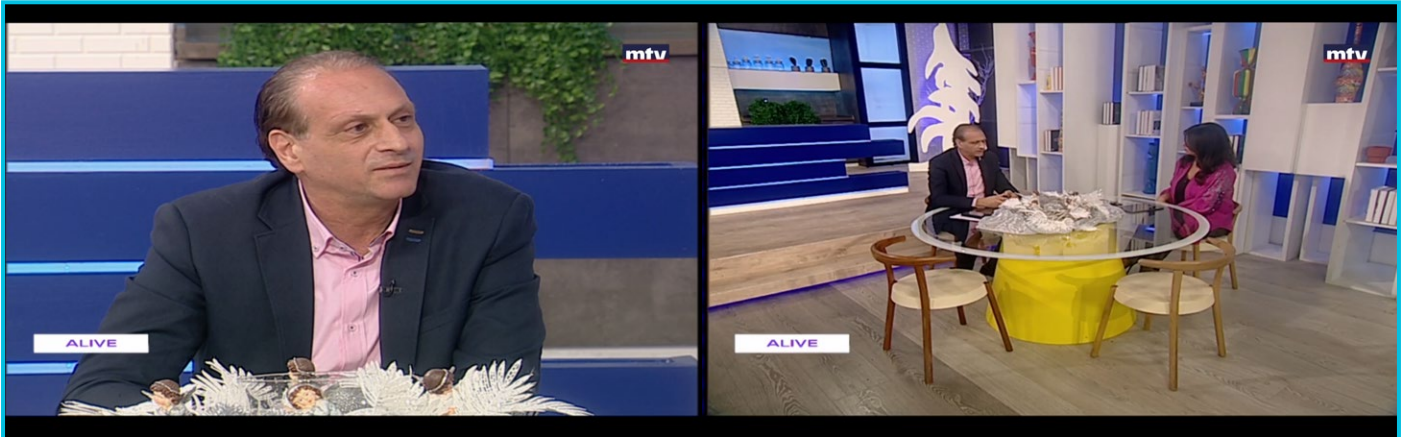

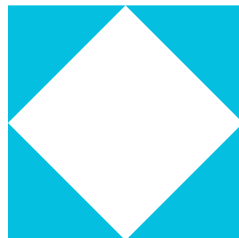
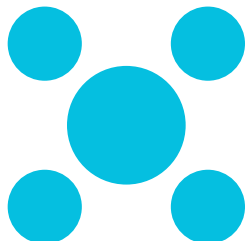


PMILC PRESIDENT LIVE INTERVIEW ON MTV

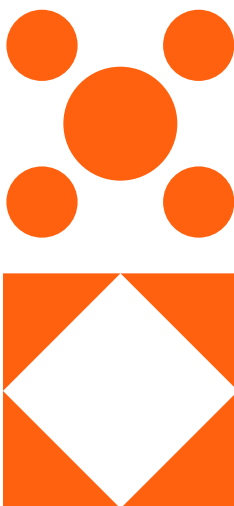
