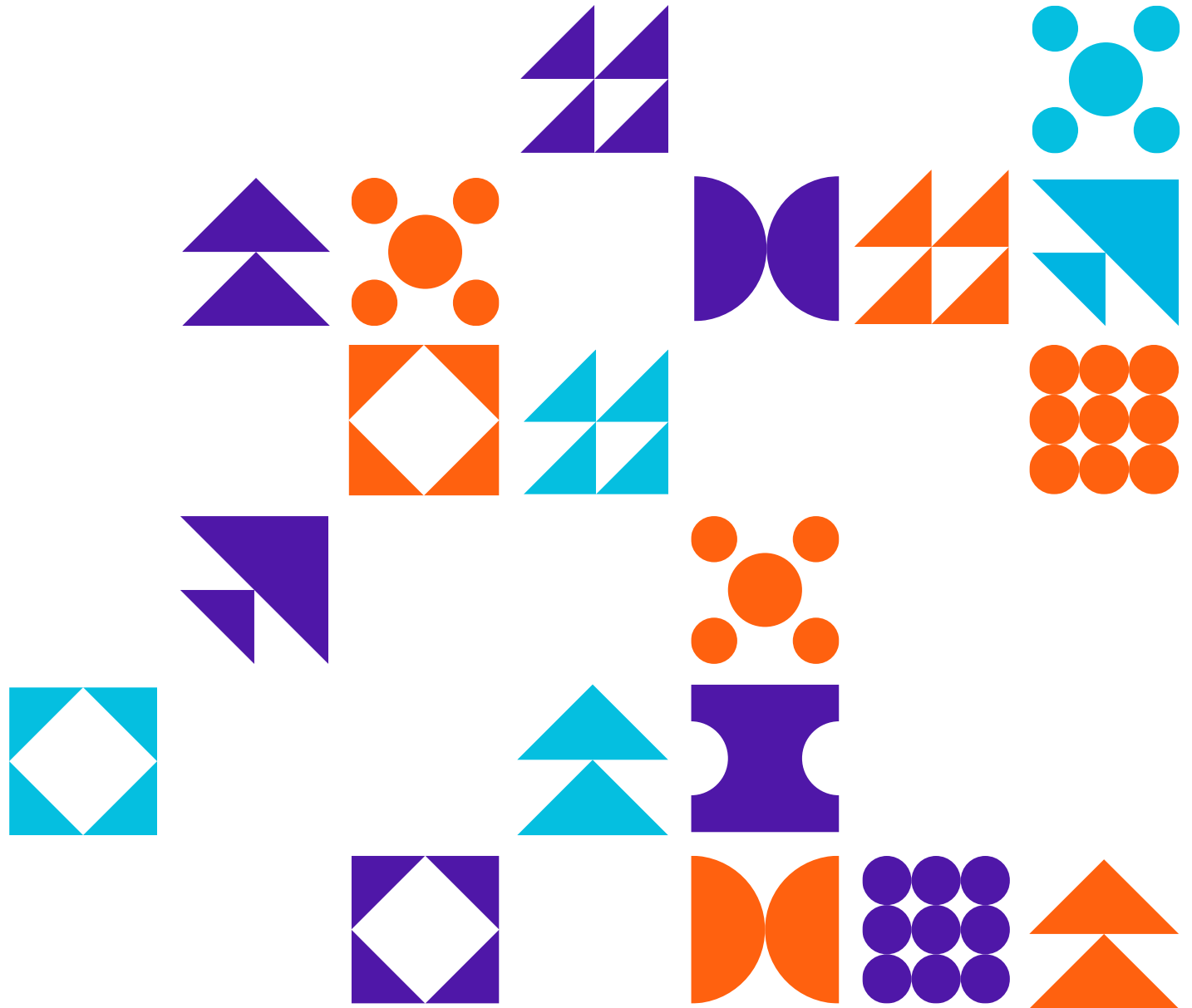

---

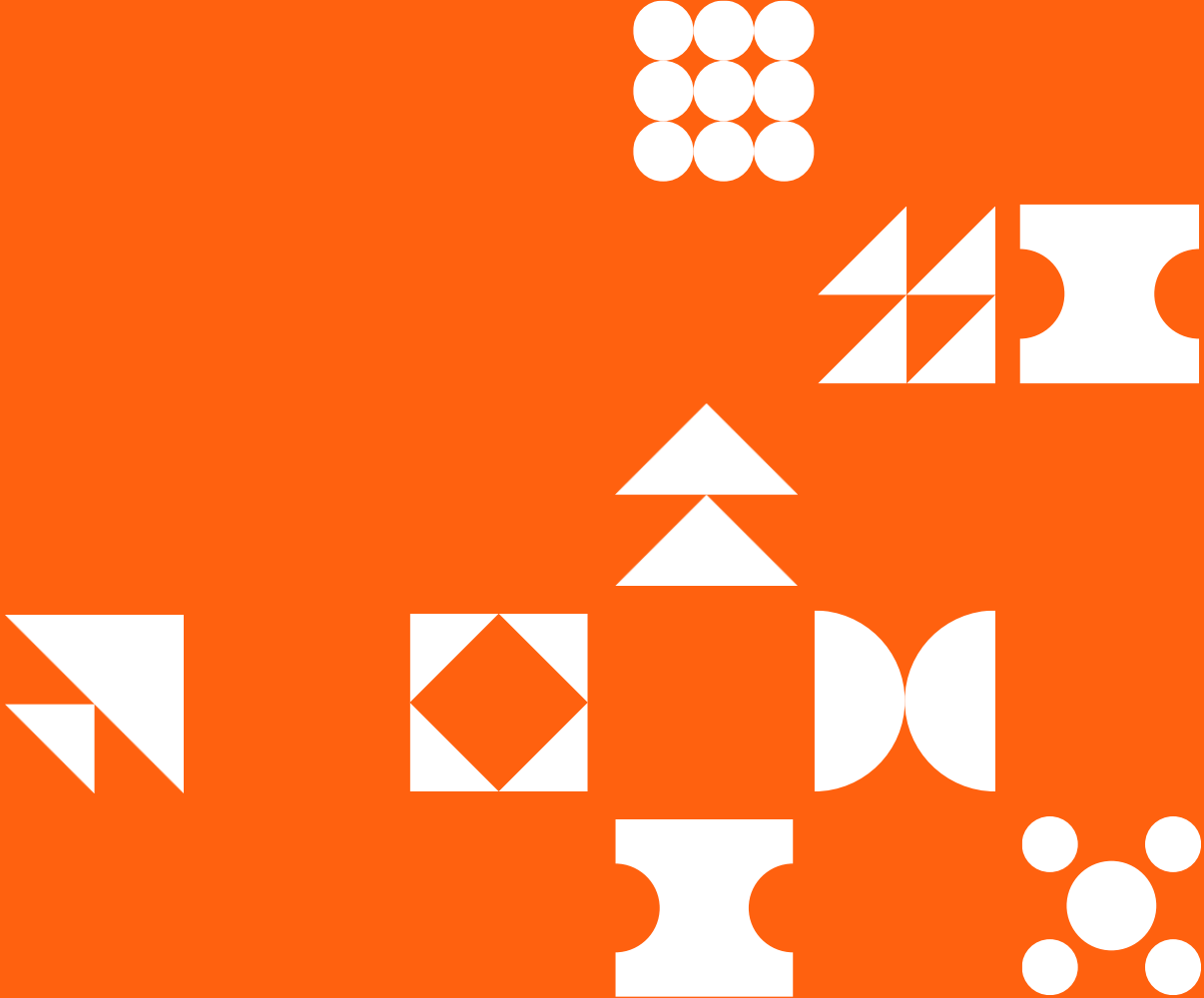
- Largest PMI chapter in the world

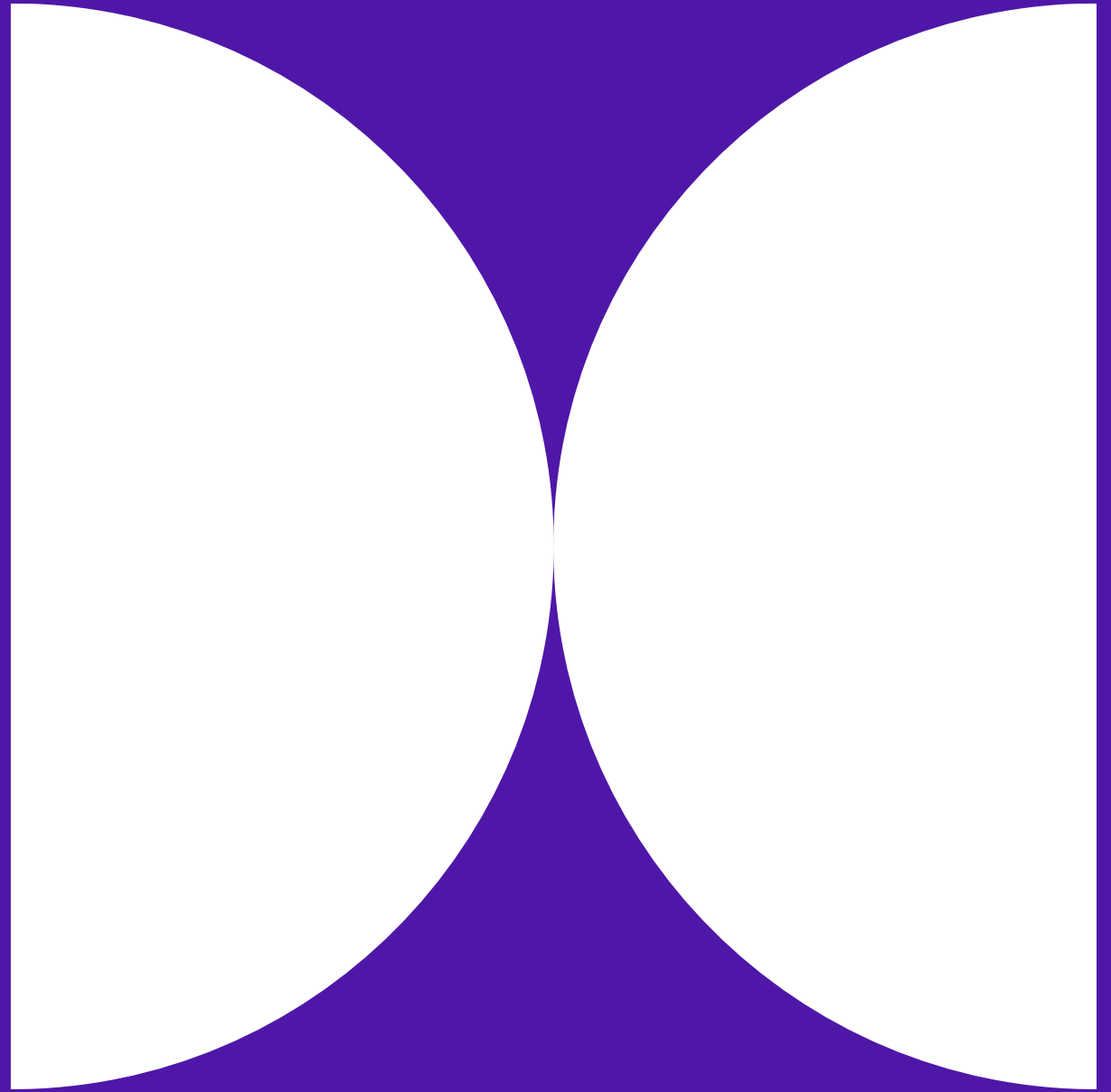

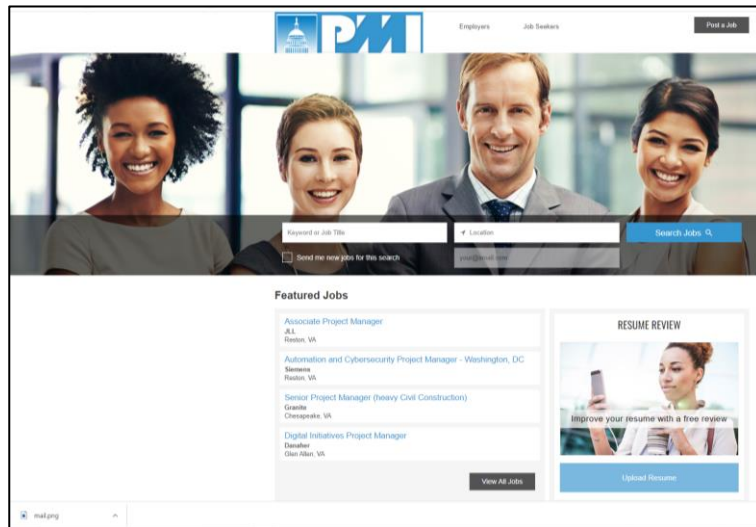

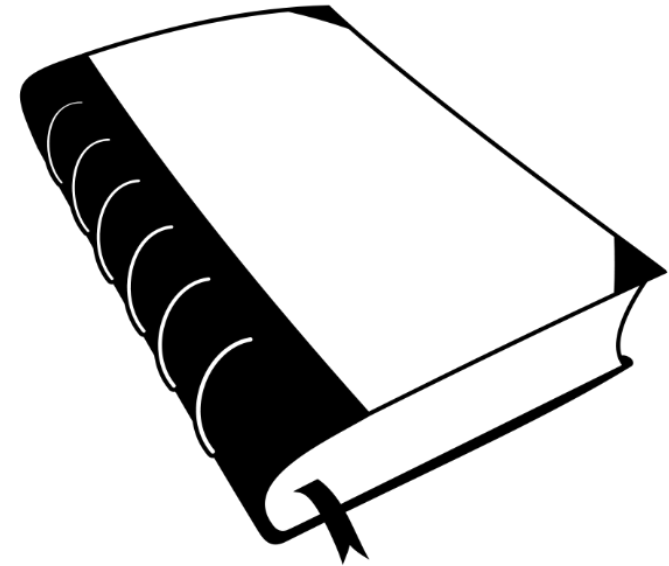
