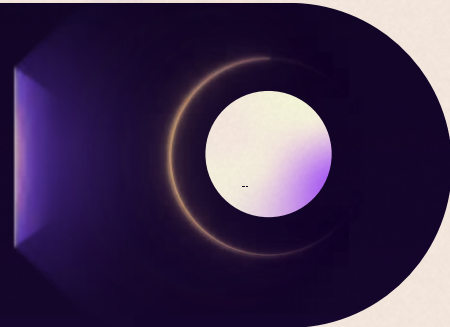
PMI:Next gave us focus on what we're trying to achieve, and we've made some great strides already

- Strategic acquisitions like Cognilytica, PMO Global Alliance, and integrations like Project Managers Without Borders and Agile Alliance, which expand our expertise, impact and bring our broader vision of project work to life.
- A comprehensive overhaul of PMI's digital presence, including the upcoming launch of a new mobile app in 2025 for a more seamless user experience.

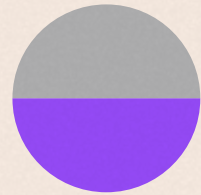
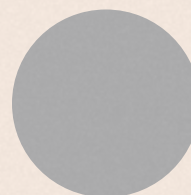

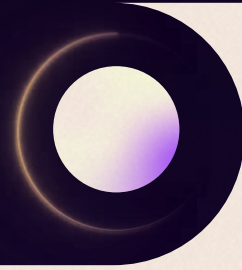
We were able to shine a spotlight on projects and professionals maximizing impact in unexpected places, and showcase the work our ecosystem is doing to illuminate paths for the next generation.

We spent much of 2024
working to understand

Under the guidance of a group of global expert practitioners, executives and academics, we gathered more than 10,000 project professionals across multiple geographies and industries to complete a rigorous survey, supplemented with more than 150 in-depth interviews. It was the largest research study ever undertaken at PMI.

Our work reiterated the need to reframe project success to reflect broader value and stakeholder expectations. To move beyond excellence in execution - project management success - to a broader view of the value created - project success.

With this critical paradigm shift, we are pioneering a broader vision for project management. A vision that will help us further our efforts to: Maximize Project Success to Elevate our World.

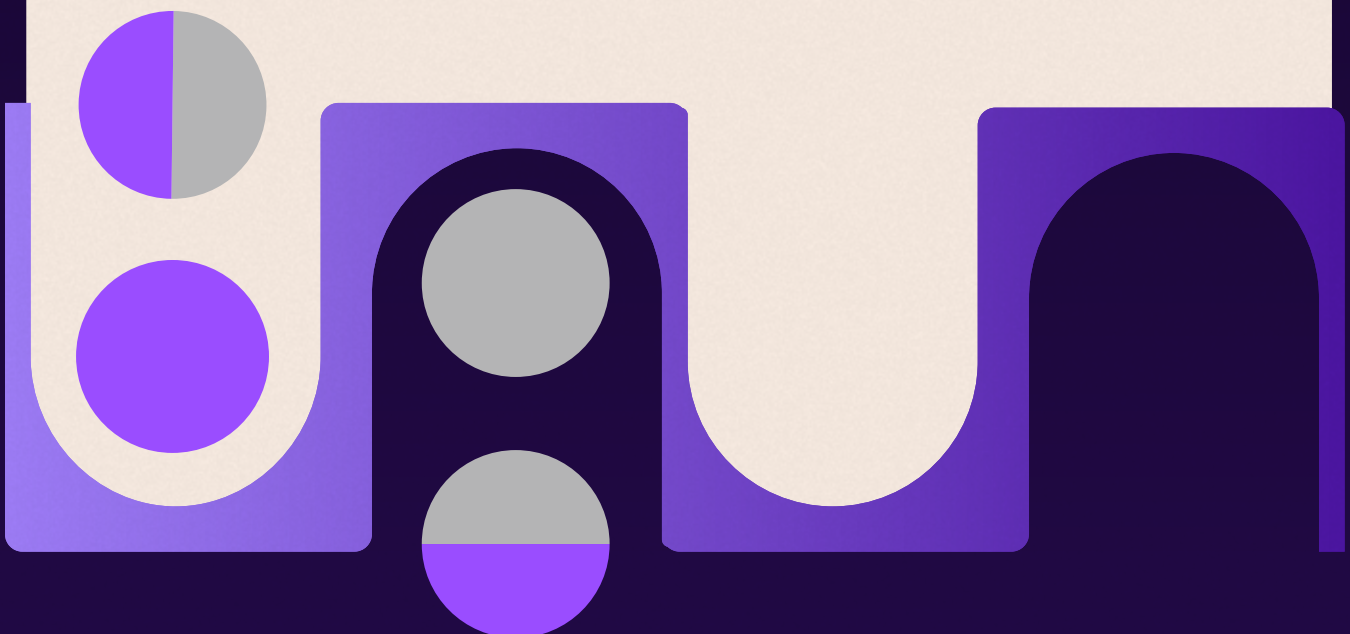


Maximize = M.O.R.E. Success

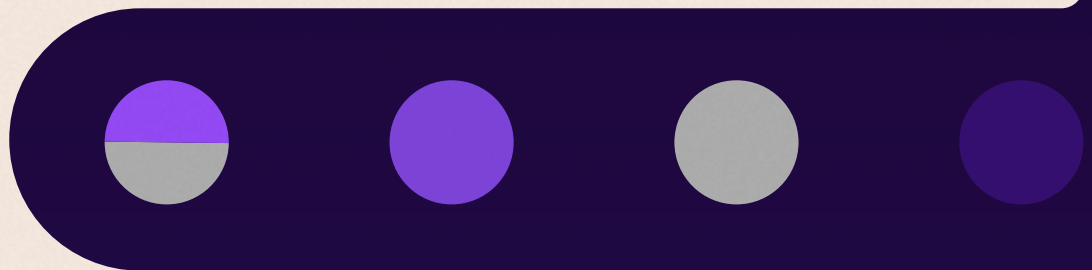
- We need MORE projects to succeed, so as to elevate our world.
- We need our profession to deliver MORE perceived value, so as to maximize project success.

It all boils down to M.O.R.E.



Why is M.O.R.E. Critical to Maximizing Project Success?

- M.O.R.E. encapsulates our efforts to expand the definition of project success and the impact of our profession.
- M.O.R.E. is not about doing more work it's about doing work that delivers MORE success.
- Historically, project success has been narrowly defined by the triple constraints of scope, budget, and schedule.
- Even when the concepts of benefits, quality and value were included in “scope”, they are often not consistently reassessed and measured towards the need to those that projects intend to serve.
- We believe that assessing projects only through execution metrics is not fully relevant in a world of hyper-competition, unstable regulations and policies, and fast-paced innovation.
- A successful project is one that delivers value that is worth the effort and expense, as perceived by most stakeholders. The implications for the project community are multiple, and it boils down to how can we ensure our profession delivers M.O.R.E.



Our 2025 Call to Action: M.O.R.E.

Manage Perceptions: For a project to be considered successful, the key stakeholders—customers, executives, or others—must perceive that the project's outputs provide sufficient value relative to the perceived investment of resources.

O

Own Success: Project professionals need to take ownership of the entire breadth of a project, moving as much as possible beyond literal mandates and executing on requirements. and take accountability for delivering tangible and perceived value that is clear to key stakeholders while minimizing waste.

R

Relentlessly Reassess Project Parameters: Project professionals need to recognize the reality of inevitable and ongoing change, and continuously, in collaboration with stakeholders, reassess the perception of value and adjust plans.

E


Expand Perspective: All projects have impacts beyond just the scope of the project itself. We all must consider the broader picture and how the project fits within the larger business, goals or objectives of the enterprise, and ultimately, our world.

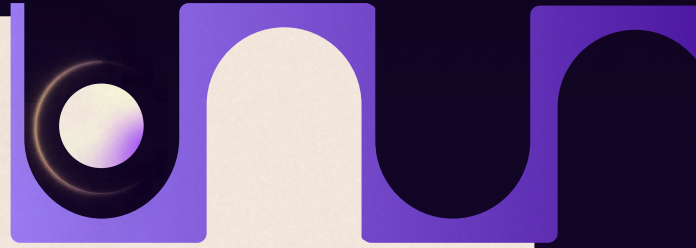

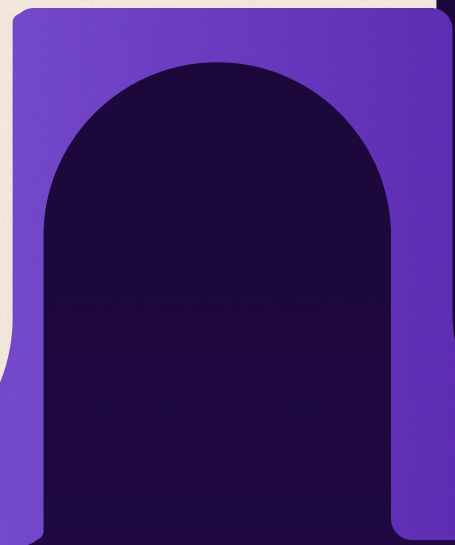
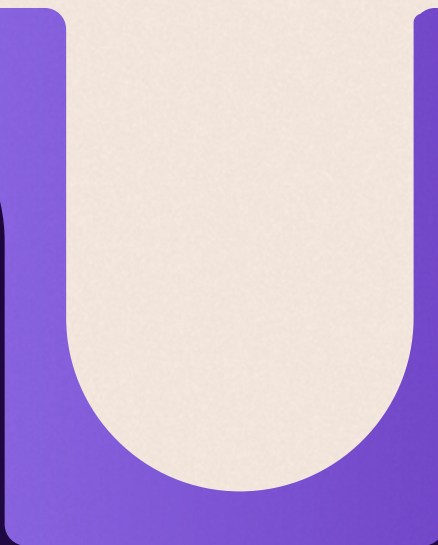
Current Resources for Delivering M.O.R.E.
