

# CCR and PDU Options

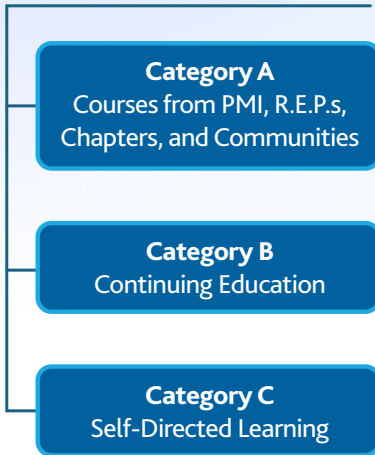
For Certification Renewal Dates Before 1 December 2017

If your renewal date is **before** 1 December 2017, you **are not** bound to the new requirements until your next certification cycle begins. The prior Continuing Certification Requirements (CCR) program framework is still applicable.

## Prior CCR Framework



### Education



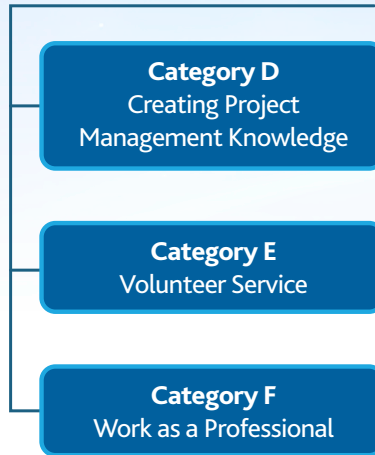
**No maximum PDU limit on Education.**

**Category C maximum:**

- 30 PDUs for a 60 PDU certification
- 15 PDUs for a 30 PDU certification



### Giving Back



**Giving Back maximum:**

- 45 PDUs for a 60 PDU certification
- 20 PDUs for a 30 PDU certification



**Category F maximum:**

- 15 PDUs for a 60 PDU certification
- 7.5 PDUs for a 30 PDU certification

# CCR Program

## Prior vs. New PDU Classifications

Your dashboard in CCRS will reflect the prior CCR program requirements until your next cycle begins. Until that point, when you enter PDUs in CCRS, keep in mind how the new classifications of PDUs relate to the former classifications. The table below details how the classifications of PDUs are aligned:

\*Category A is any provider that can be found within CCRS. This includes providers such as PMI, a R.E.P., chapter, projectmanagement.com, etc.
