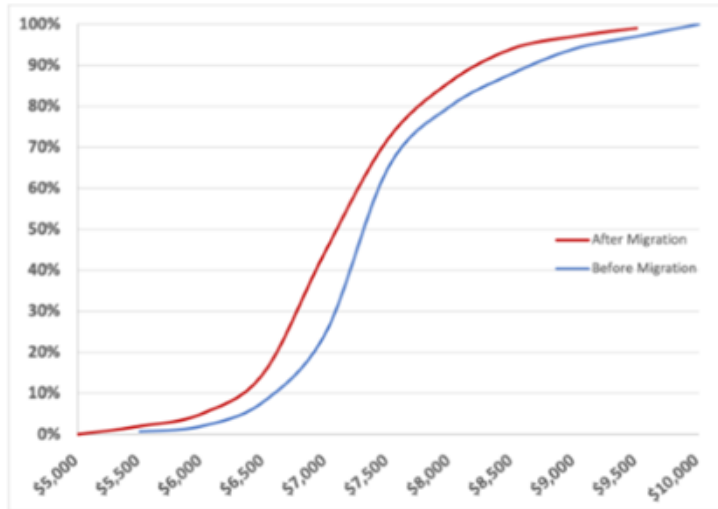
For questions on definitions and process order, the PMP may include items that leverage a drag and drop question. In the example on the left, candidates will drag the process to match up to its respective process group.

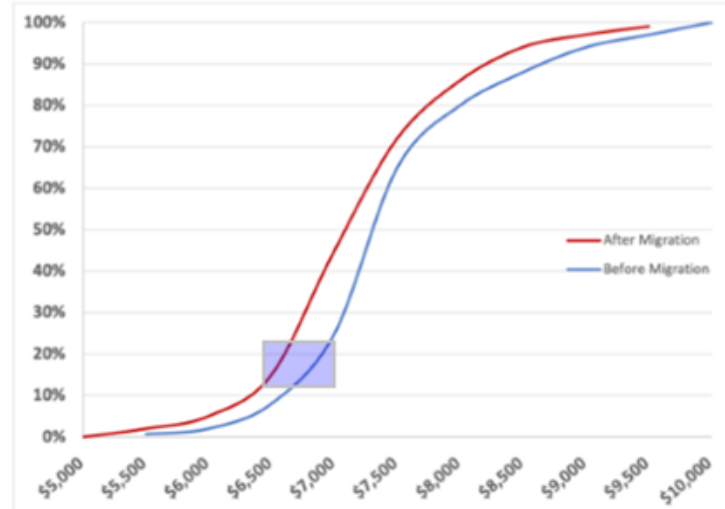
