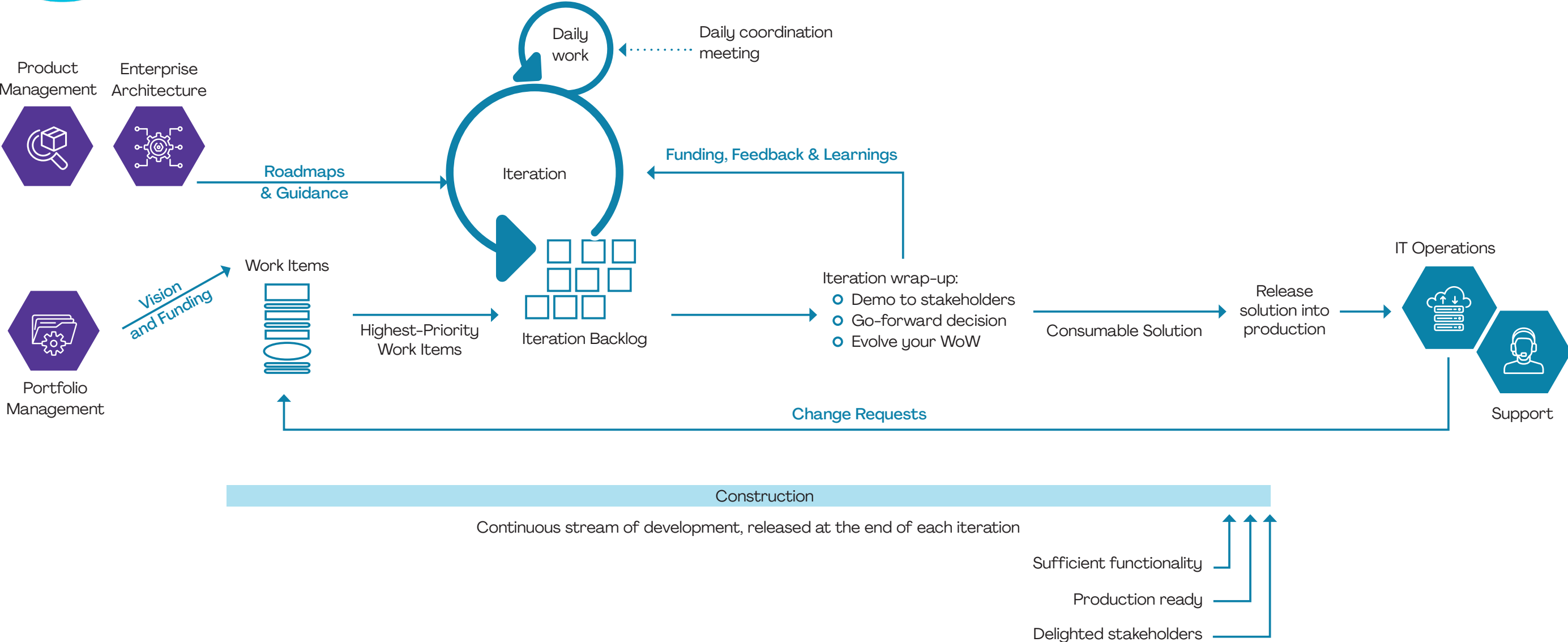


# DA's Continuous Delivery: Agile Lifecycle



Disciplined Agile (DA)'s Continuous Delivery: Agile lifecycle is a natural progression from the DA's Agile lifecycle. Teams typically evolve to this lifecycle from the Agile lifecycle, often adopting iteration lengths of one-week or less. The key difference between this and the Agile lifecycle is that the Continuous Delivery: Agile lifecycle results in a release of new functionality at the end of each iteration rather than after several iterations. Automation and technical practices are critical to your success.
